After its inception and for many decades to come, AAAE focused on its primary goal of assisting airport executives in fulfilling their responsibilities to the airports and communities they serve.

In the early 1990s, major global barriers around the world began to dissolve. Combined with the seemingly limitless possibilities offered by the Internet and other technology innovations, as well as the "open skies" agreements reached between the U.S. and other nations, the world became a smaller place as air travel among countries around the globe expanded at a rapid pace.

To respond to these increasing opportunities — and the great challenges that came along with them — AAAE's commitment to professional excellence went international in 1992 with the creation of the International Association of Airport Executives (IAAE), an affiliated AAAE organization. The formation of IAAE-Central Europe was completed in 2001.

Categories

IAAE AFFILIATE

Open to any individual who has active responsibility for the management or staff functions of a public airport.

IAAE ASSOCIATE

Open to individuals who are otherwise not eligible for membership yet wish to be more closely identified with the airport industry. Many companies not wishing to opt for corporate membership find this category most valuable.

IAAE CORPORATE

Individual representatives of companies and corporations, either public or private, usually with a product or service of interest to airport management, who wish to participate in IAAE activities and further their contacts with the airport management profession. Corporate membership is also open to universities with aviation management curriculums. These members receive substantial savings on marketing and promotional opportunities for their products or services. IAAE airport executive members are encouraged to buy products and services from IAAE corporate members.
